

Photovac Laser intent to sell/trade minimum Firearms within in the city limits Grove City Ohio.

OBJECTIVE: To meet the requirements for the Federal Firearms Licensing (FFL)

- A) To become a dealer in firearms other than destructive devices. Includes (Rifle, Shotgun, Pistol, Revolver)
- B) The business to be conducted under the Federal Firearms License laws. To comply with the local zoning ordinances of Grove City. To provide gun safety courses and classroom training.
- C) No ammunition will be sold or stored on site.
- D) Within 30 days after the application is approved, the business will comply with the requirements of State and local Law applicable to conduct the business.
- E) That a secure gun storage gun safe that will be on premises that is designed to be unlocked on by a means of combination.
- F) Sales of Firearms will be by appointment only. Appoints shall be made by email, in-person registration or by telephone.
- G) To maintain a bond book of commercial documents maintained on the premises. Documents will include sales to individuals and/or transfers of firearms.
- H) To maintain electronic surveillance of the premises by cameras. To maintain building protection by alarm attached to a central location.

1)

- A) The existing character of the area is not affected in any manner. Clients that visit the business are prescheduled visitors. Our business will encourage new visitors to the Grove City area and other business within the district.

- B) There is no effect on the adjacent properties. Currently, the Fast Lane Drive Thru and adjacent car detailing service to our southwest is a dirty mess operating in a dilapidated structure. The building that houses a security service, "Accurate Security Ohio", also to our southwest, is another dilapidated building with holes in the siding. The building was formerly used as a paintball business. The business used the back of the building for paint ball practice and destroyed the siding. The City should request new siding to update the unsightly looking buildings for our potential clients visiting the Grove City Area. The parking areas of these structures also are in poor shape with crumbling blacktop. The carwash, are also to our southwest attracts all different types. In many cases loud music plays from vehicles and disrupts our business operations. The loud music ordinances are not adhered to and the property owners of the carwash should be held accountable. Being good neighbors, Photovac Laser Corporation and Interstate Construction don't complain to the city or law enforcement. National Car Rental and Memories Restaurant are visited often by local and non-local visitors. No further demographics of these visitors are known to Photovac Laser.

- C) There is no effect on the health and safety or welfare of the person residing or working in the area. Our clients are few; vesting only on pre-scheduled hours of operation.

2) Project narrative information:

- A) There are no potential effects on adjacent uses such as noise to affect other businesses. As described above, noise effects are experienced from the drive-thru and car detailing business (loud radio music) and carwash facility (loud car music) on Photovac Lasers and Interstate Constructions business.

- B) Our proposed sales are by scheduled visitors and select clientele. We adhere to all Local, State and Federal Firearm ordinances. Photovac Lasers is a world recognized leader of Co2 laser products and services. Our expansion into firearm sales has been approved by the Board of Directors. Our Firearms Director Joseph Muse is in charge of annual meetings with the ATF, firearm sales records and client sales
- C) All business, with the exception of 2 hours on Fridays 3:00PM to 5:00PM are by appointment only Monday thru Friday. Saturday and Sundays are by appointment only.
- 3) Floor Plan where transactions and training will be conducted.

Please see the attached floor plans with our transactions and training locations. Training is defined as oral and written training only. No "live" firearms training will be held onsite. All transactions will be held in the front of the building located on the drawing. Gun Storage will be maintained in a large gun safe in the meeting and training room. The premises are well guarded by cameras and monitored by ADT security. All windows are alarmed and doors have dead bolts.








