## DIRECTIONS

### From the east or west:

Take I-270 around the south side of Columbus.  
Exit I-270 at Grove City/U.S. Route 62 (Exit 2).

Go south on U.S. Route 62/Broadway for 1.75  
miles to Columbus St. Turn left on Columbus  
St. Go 0.2 miles to Dudley Ave. (opposite St.  
John's Lutheran Church). Turn right. Street will  
end in Windsor Park, the location of the Evans  
Center.

### From the north or south

Take I-71 to Exit 100/Stringtown Road. Turn  
west on Stringtown Road. Proceed for 2 miles  
(Stringtown Rd. becomes Columbus St. after 1  
mile). Turn left onto Dudley Ave. (opposite St.  
John's Lutheran Church). Street ends in  
Windsor Park and the parking lot next to the  
Evans Center parking lot.
