Youth Basketball Frequently Asked Questions

Cost: Recreation league fees: \$83 for Grove City residents; \$88 for all other participants

Practices: Practice schedules are given to each coach at the coaches' meeting.
Practices begin the week of Monday, Dec. 8. Teams will practice one hour each week.
Due to lack of facility space, some practices will be scheduled from 8:30-9:30 p.m. If schools are closed due to inclement weather, practices will not be held or made up.
****ROSTERS WILL NOT BE ADJUSTED TO ACCOMMODATE PRACTICE TIMES.****

Games: Each team plays one game per week.

Game dates are:

Official schedules are passed out to each team at practice before the season begins.

***Post-season tournaments for grades three through 12.**

Observations: Participants in several age groups in the youth basketball program have their performance evaluated in an informal observation to help balance teams. **Please make sure your child is present 15 minutes before his/her scheduled observation time. Children of head and assistant coaches need to attend the observations.** Participants who cannot attend are assigned to teams in a blind draft. Children are graded by the Youth Sports Advisory Board.

Everyone must wear athletic shoes, shorts and a shirt to the observation.

Picture Day: Individual and team pictures are taken at each game site on **Saturday, Jan. 17.** Coaches will hand out picture day information before the first game.

Uniforms: Uniforms are ordered immediately following the coaches' meeting. Due to the timely nature of uniform ordering, exchanges cannot be honored. Please double check the size you ordered (sample clothing is available at sign-ups). A reversible mesh jersey is provided. We ask participants to wear black or navy blue shorts to games.

Jerseys must remain tucked in during games.

Team Assignments:	Volunteer coaches contact each player assigned to their team after the coaches' meeting. Information concerning practice days and times is given to players at that time.
Winter Break:	There are no practices or games between Monday, Dec. 22 and Sunday, Jan. 4, as South-Western City Schools facilities are closed for winter break.
Weather Hotline:	In the event of inclement weather, please call the weather update/information hotline at 614-277-3060. Press # 4 for field conditions and then # 5 for local gym conditions.
Background Checks:	All coaches undergo a background check before coaching with the Grove City Parks and Recreational youth leagues.
Coaches' Meeting:	(Head Coaches Only) The meeting is held at City Hall, 4035 Broadway, on Tuesday, Dec. 2 at 6 p.m.
Honoring Requests:	Balancing talent levels is the primary goal when assembling teams in each division. Unfortunately, we do not accept player requests. The only exception is for siblings and children living in the same household where age and gender would place them in the same grade division. The Parks and Recreation Department has the right to honor certain requests that may arise.
Coaches Needed:	Coaches are needed for all grade divisions. Coaching applications are available in the Parks and Recreation office and online. Coaches' children must attend the observations, if appropriate. Background checks are performed on coaching applications.
NYSCA Coaches' Clinics:	All head coaches in the program are required to be certified through the National Youth Sports Coaches Association (NYSCA). The Grove City Parks and Recreation Department will pay the annual fee for all head coaches. Head coaches who are not certified can get certified online at www.nays.org/nyscaonline/ . Coaches already certified through NYSCA who need their certification updated should call Michael Craig at 614-277-3050. Note: Coaches are not required to attend this online clinic every year. Once you attend the initial clinic, the certification is renewed on an annual basis. *Important: Head coaches who receive a renewal notice in the mail from the NYSCA should bring it to City Hall immediately. The Parks and Recreation Department will pay this fee for active head coaches.
Required Concussion Education for Coaches:	Per Ohio law, a coach for a youth sports organization must complete a training program in recognizing the signs and symptoms of concussions and head injuries provided by the Ohio Department of Health every three years. The obligation also is fulfilled by holding a Pupil Activity Permit from the Ohio Department of Education or completing a similar program authorized and required by an organization that regulates interscholastic conferences or events. The Ohio Department of Health has approved free online training available through the National Federation of State High School Associations (NFHS). Click the "order here" button and complete a brief registration form to take the course. Membership in NFHS is not required.
