## How do I donate a tree?

Donating a tree is simple as 1,2,3.

1. Contact the urban forester at 614-277-1100 to discuss your options and choices.
2. Fill out the form on the inside flap of this pamphlet. Please be sure to fill out all the information completely so we can keep accurate records.
3. Return your form along with the \$300 fee to the City of Grove City Parks and Recreation Department, 4035 Broadway, Grove City, Ohio 43123. Checks should be made payable to: **The City of Grove City**. Your donation is 100 percent tax deductible.

Upon receipt of your order, you will be contacted by a City representative about the planting date and time. Donors are welcome to attend the planting.

Why?

### Why should I donate a tree?

### Commemorative Tree Species

Trees are classed in three categories:

- Small (25-30' at maturity)
- Medium (30-45' at maturity)
- Large (47-75' at maturity)

### Where will my tree be planted?

Commemorative tree donations will be planted in Fryer Park, Gantz Park, Windsor Park, Henceroth Park and other areas as they develop. Exact location within the park will be determined based on need and the type of tree you choose. Placement determination is the sole responsibility of the City.

How much?

### What does it cost to donate a tree?

The cost of the commemorative tree program is \$300. This includes a 1-3/4" caliper tree of your choice, tree planting and a commemorative plaque. The City cares for all City-owned trees.

Commemorative trees will be included in the City's scheduled tree maintenance program, which includes pruning, watering and mulching. The City will transplant or replace any commemorative tree threatened by land use or site changes during the lifetime of the tree.
