

ORDINANCE C-22-95

AN ORDINANCE TO APPROPRIATE \$7,500.00 FROM THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT FUND FOR THE CURRENT EXPENSE OF PROMOTING THE BIA "NEW HOME SHOW"

WHEREAS, the Building Industry Association (BIA) will sponsor the "New Home Show" in Grove City from August 26 through September 4, 1995; and

WHEREAS, the New Home Show will attract approximately 30,000 visitors to our community during the show, who will visit our businesses and invigorate our local economy; and

WHEREAS, the Grove City Area Chamber of Commerce and the Grove City Area Visitors and Convention Bureau recognize the importance of the New Home Show to create a positive image for our City and have jointly committed \$7,500 to the promotion and operation of the event; and

WHEREAS, the Community Development Fund is generated solely by hotel/motel bed tax receipts and exists to promote our City to other communities and visitors as a wonderful place to visit and live; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to match the contribution of the Chamber and Convention Bureau and assist the BIA with the promotion and operation of the "New Home Show".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GROVE CITY, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:




SECTION 2. This ordinance appropriates for current expenses and shall therefore go into immediate effect.
