

ORDINANCE NO. C-23-90

AN ORDINANCE TO APPROPRIATE \$16,125.00 FROM THE
SEWER FUND FOR CURRENT EXPENSES

WHEREAS, changes in the operation requirements of the Indian Trails Wastewater Treatment Plant now exceed the technical expertise of the city staff; and

WHEREAS, the operation of this plant is a temporary condition which is a result of the extended time required to construct the Grant Run Sanitary Trunk Sewer; and

WHEREAS, the employment of a licensed operator for the plant is a legal requirement; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GROVE CITY, STATE OF OHIO, THAT


SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated \$16,125.00 from the unappropriated monies of the Sewer Fund to hire a licensed operator for the Indian Trails Wastewater Treatment Plant until the completion of the Grant Run Trunk Sewer.


