

ORDINANCE C-44-02

AN ORDINANCE TO APPROPRIATE \$35,000.00 FROM THE GENERAL FUND FOR THE CURRENT EXPENSE OF BIKE PATH INSTALLATION AT EVANS PARK AND TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO EXECUTE CONSTRUCTION CONTRACTS

WHEREAS, the City of Grove City has received a matching grant from the Ohio Department of Transportation for the construction and engineering of a bike path at Evans Park for 55% of the cost of cost not to exceed \$39,050.00; and

WHEREAS, this project requires the appropriation of the City's match of \$35,000.00 to meet the grant conditions and to allow for the City to execute construction contracts that was not addressed in the Annual Appropriation Ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GROVE CITY, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:


SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated \$35,000.00 from the unappropriated monies of the General Fund for the Current Expense of bike path construction.




