

ORDINANCE C-58-94

AN ORDINANCE TO APPROPRIATE \$50,000 FROM THE GENERAL FUND FOR THE CURRENT EXPENSE OF LEGAL FEES

WHEREAS, the City Council annually appropriates funds for legal services; and

WHEREAS, depending on the volume and type of lawsuits which occur during the year, said funds occasionally do not adequately cover the appropriated funds; and

WHEREAS, the City of Grove City encountered a major lawsuit with Beulah Park Limited Partnership which is still ongoing; and

WHEREAS, over \$50,000.00 has been expended.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GROVE CITY, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated \$50,000 from the unappropriated monies of the General Fund for the Current Expense of legal fees.

SECTION 2. This ordinance appropriates for current expenses and shall therefore go into immediate effect.
