

ORDINANCE C-75-02

AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH THE LINCOLN AVENUE CDBG FUND AND APPROPRIATE \$225,783.00 FROM SAID FUND FOR THE CURRENT EXPENSE OF ROAD RECONSTRUCTION

WHEREAS, the City has received notification from Franklin County Commissioners of the award of a Community Development Block Grant for Lincoln Avenue; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to GAAP it is necessary to establish a separate fund to account for the project expenses related to this grant; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for Council to appropriate the grant money for the project use.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GROVE CITY, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. There is hereby established the Lincoln Avenue CDBG Fund.



SECTION 3. This ordinance appropriates for current expenses and shall therefore go into immediate effect.






