

ORDINANCE NO. C-11-86

AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE ADMINISTRATIVE ASSISTANT TO
CONTRACT WITH VEHICLE WRECKING YARDS FOR THE STORAGE OF
VEHICLES AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, under certain conditions the Division of Police must remove vehicles from the streets and alleys of the city to insure public safety; and

WHEREAS, the proper storage of these vehicles is needed; and


WHEREAS, an emergency exists that affects the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the city that the arrangements for storage be made as soon as possible for public safety;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GROVE CITY, STATE OF OHIO, THAT

SECTION 1. The Administrative Assistant is hereby authorized to enter into contracts with storage lots provided they meet the following conditions:


1. The storage lot is in compliance with the zoning and building codes;
2. Such business is carried on entirely inside of a building or in an open area enclosed by a nontransparent fence at least six feet in height, built of sound material, uniform in height and constructed so that it is structurally safe.
3. All areas within the fence shall be asphalt concrete, portland concrete or gravel. Said areas shall be approved by the City Engineer to insure proper drainage.
4. Said business shall carry a "Garage Keeper Policy" written on a direct primary basis for a minimum of \$300,000.00 with minimum deductables of \$100.00 comprehensive and \$250.00 collision. Copies of all insurance policies, endorsements thereto and receipts for payment of premiums shall be deposited with the Administrative Assistant.
5. All contracts shall contain a certificate of premium payment from the Industrial Commission and Bureau of Workers' Compensation from the State of Ohio.
6. All contracts shall contain an indemnification clause stating to the fullest extent permitted by law, the business shall indemnify and hold harmless the City from and against all claims, damages, losses and expenses, including but not limited to, attorney's fees arising out of or resulting from the performance of their work.
7. All contracts shall require towing availability on a twenty-four hour a day basis and availability for persons having vehicles in said lot the opportunity to recover their vehicle.
8. Each business will keep and maintain records as required by the Administrative Assistant.

SECTION 2. This ordinance is hereby declared an emergency measure and shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and the approval of the Mayor.


