

ORDINANCE C-113-90

AN ORDINANCE TO APPROPRIATE \$150,000 FROM THE GENERAL FUND
FOR THE CURRENT EXPENSE OF ADVANCEMENT OF FUNDS TO THE
GARDENS AT GANTZ FUND

WHEREAS, the city received a grant from the State of Ohio for \$150,000 for the construction of the Gardens at Gantz Park; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance C-68-90 appropriated said funds based on the expectation of receipt of monies within the City fiscal year 1990; and

WHEREAS, the necessity exists, under state law and generally accepted accounting principals (GAAP) to advance \$150,000 until such time as the state money is received;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GROVE CITY, STATE OF OHIO, THAT

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated the amount of \$150,000 from the unappropriated monies of the General Fund to be advanced to the Garden at Gantz Fund.

SECTION 2. The Director of Finance is directed to execute this advance on the condition that \$150,000 grant from the State of Ohio is not receipted to the treasury of The City of Grove City by December 31, 1990.

SECTION 3. This ordinance appropriates for current expenses and shall therefore go into immediate effect.




