

ORDINANCE C - 20 - 66

AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE ADMINISTRATIVE ASSISTANT, AS PURCHASING AGENT, TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS ON A PICK-UP TRUCK AND TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, it is necessary in the operation of the Service Department to acquire additional equipment for the preservation of public health, safety and welfare.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Grove City, State of Ohio, that

SECTION 1. The administrative assistant, as the purchasing agent, is hereby authorized and directed to advertise for bids for a Pick-up Truck for the Water Department.

SECTION 2. Upon completion of said advertising, the administrative assistant, as purchasing agent, is authorized to award and enter into a contract with the lowest and best bidder according to law.

SECTION 3. The administrative assistant, as the purchasing agent is further authorized to trade one pick-up truck as a part payment for such purchase.

SECTION 4. That for reasons stated in the preamble hereto and made a part hereof, this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
