IMPROVEMENT


WHEREAS, in 1984 approximately \$400,000.00 was spent for the Kingston Avenue Improvement; and

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated \$80,000 from the unappropriated monies of the General Fund and \$20,000 from the Water Fund for the said improvement.


SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take effect at the earliest opportunity allowed by law.







ORDINANCE NO. C-22-85

AN ORDINANCE TO APPROPRIATE \$10,000 FOR THE ENGINEERING PLANS
FOR THE REMOVAL OF THE INDIAN TRAILS SEWAGE TREATMENT PLANT

WHEREAS, the Indian Trails Sewage Treatment Plant is quickly reaching its capacity; and

WHEREAS, the area served by this plant is being developed which necessitates major improvements or the elimination of the plant; and

WHEREAS, it is the recommendation of the administration that the most cost effective approach is to abandon this plant and tie into the City of Columbus sewer system;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GROVE CITY, STATE OF OHIO, THAT



SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take effect at the earliest opportunity allowed by law.


