

ORDINANCE NO. C-22-83

AN ORDINANCE TO ACCEPT THE PLAT OF PARKSIDE VILLAGE
AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Plat of Parkside Village, containing 7.665 acres and being a subdivision of Reserve "A" of Parkside Estates, has been submitted to Council for their consideration; and

WHEREAS, this council has accepted the development plan for this project; and

WHEREAS, an emergency exists that affects the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the city that this project begin as soon as possible for its timely completion;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GROVE CITY, STATE OF OHIO, THAT

SECTION 1. The Plat of Parkside Village, containing 7.665 acres, situated in the State of Ohio, County of Franklin, City of Grove City and located in part of Virginia Military Survey No. 6839, containing 8.054 acres of land, more or less, said 7.665 acres being part of the 8.054 acres conveyed to Valerio S. Canini Builder, Inc. by deed of record in Official Record 957, Page C-14, all record references to those of the Recorder's Office, Franklin County, Ohio is hereby accepted.


SECTION 2. Easements, where indicated on the plat, are hereby accepted for public utility services, including by not limited to water, sanitary sewer, electricity and telephone; for companies providing cable television and cable signal transmission services and by this city responsible for storm water drainage systems for the construction, operation and maintenance of the facilities to provide such services and systems above and beneath the ground.

SECTION 3. For reasons stated in the preamble and made a part hereof, this ordinance is declared an emergency measure and shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and the approval of the Mayor.


