

ORDINANCE NO. C-28-69

AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE ADMINISTRATIVE ASSISTANT TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH A COMPETENT AND ACCREDITED ENGINEER OR ENGINEERING FIRM TO PREPARE PLANS FOR THE EXTENSION OF SOUTHWEST BOULEVARD TO DEMOREST ROAD, TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS THEREFOR, AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, an emergency exists in the usual daily operation of the City of Grove City, in that it is immediately necessary that this council enter into a contract for engineering plans for the extension of Southwest Boulevard to Demorest Road, in order to preserve the public peace health and safety.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GROVE CITY, STATE OF OHIO, THAT

SECTION 1. The administrative assistant is hereby authorized and directed to enter into an agreement with a competent and accredited engineer or engineering firm to prepare plans for the extension of Southwest Boulevard westerly to Demorest Road and including plans for water and sanitary sewer lines to serve the area between Broadway and Demorest Road in the vicinity of the proposed Southwest Boulevard extension.

SECTION 2. The sum of \$5,000 or so much thereof as may be needed be and it is hereby appropriated from the Street Fund.

SECTION 3. The sum of \$2,500 or so much thereof as may be needed be and it is hereby appropriated from the Sewer Capital Improvement Fund.

SECTION 4. The sum of \$2,500 or so much thereof as may be needed be and it is hereby appropriated from the Water Fund.

SECTION 5. That for reasons stated in the preamble hereto and made a part hereof this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect immediately upon passage and approval of the Mayor.
