FOR CURRENT EXPENSES


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GROVE CITY,
STATE OF OHIO, THAT



ORDINANCE NO. C-34-87

AN ORDINANCE STATING NEW REQUIREMENTS
FOR D-1 AND D-2 ZONING DISTRICTS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GROVE CITY,
STATE OF OHIO, THAT

SECTION 1. Section 1135.10 (e) of the Zoning Code of the
Codified Ordinances of the City is hereby repealed and new Section
1135.10(e) is hereby enacted to read:


- (e) In areas or districts approved for D-1 and D-2
development, no two structures on adjoining lots
shall have the same exterior appearance in design,
color, style or overall appearance. Should the
builder or developer disagree with the decision of
the Building Inspector and/or City Engineer on the
appearance of adjoining structures, the Planning
Commission shall have the final approval.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take effect at the
earliest opportunity allowed by law.


