WHEREAS, in order to perpetuate the memory of the late Harry A. Yates, who contributed many years of faithful and devoted services to the City of Grove City, a street ought be named in his memory.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Grove City, State of Ohio, that

SECTION 1. The name of Harrisburg Pike within that territory annexed to the City of Grove City under the authority of Ordinances C-22-65 and C-3-66 be and the same is hereby changed to Broadway.

SECTION 2. Stringtown Pike from its western terminus at the intersection of Haughn Road and Columbus Street to its intersection at Hoover Road be and the same is hereby changed to Columbus Street.

SECTION 3. Winston Avenue from its eastern terminus, east to Hoover Road, to its western terminus, west of Hoover Road, be and the same is hereby changed to Yates Avenue.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force at the earliest opportunity allowed by law.

ORDINANCE C-38-66

AN ORDINANCE TO ADOPT, BY REFERENCE, RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE FRANKLIN COUNTY DISTRICT BOARD OF HEALTH AND CHAPTER 3707, SECTIONS 3707.01 to 3707.53, INCLUSIVE, OF THE REVISED CODE AND TO PROVIDE A PENALTY, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Grove City has entered into a contract with the Franklin County District Board of Health to perform such duties as a City Board of Health is empowered to perform under Chapter 3707 of the Revised Code; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the preservation of the public safety and health to adopt, by reference, the statutes of the State of Ohio and the rules and regulations of the Franklin County Board of Health, made pursuant to said statutes as ordinances of the City of Grove City; and

WHEREAS, such preservation of the public health directly affects the safety and health of the City and ought immediately be provided for.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Grove City, State of Ohio, that

701.01 SECTION 1. That Chapter 3707, entitled "Board of Health", of the Ohio Revised Code, Sections 3707.01 to 3707.53, inclusive, is hereby adopted by reference.

701.99 SECTION 2. That no person shall violate any order or regulation of the City Board of Health or any agency legally contracting with the City of Grove City in the performances of the duties, enumerated in Section 1, or obstruct or interfere with the execution of such order, or willfully or illegally omit to obey such order. Whosoever violates this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and fined not more than \$50.

SECTION 3. That for reasons stated in the preamble hereto and made a part hereof, this Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
