

ORDINANCE NO. C-39-73
(as amended)

AN ORDINANCE TO APPROPRIATE RIGHT OF WAY
FOR STRINGTOWN ROAD IMPROVEMENT AND TO
DECLARE AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, at its last regular session, this council declared by Resolution No. CR-20-73 the necessity and it's intent to appropriate certain properties to public use for the proposed Stringtown Road Improvement being the properties hereinafter described, and

WHEREAS, notice of the adoption of said resolution has been served on affected property owners, persons in possession or having an interest of record in said land, and

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure affecting the safety and welfare of the citizens of Grove City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GROVE CITY, STATE OF OHIO, THAT

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated, for the purpose of constructing and relocation of Stringtown Road, the land described in the unexecuted deeds attached hereto and made a part hereof. The interest appropriated is the interest described in each of the respective deeds attached hereto.

SECTION 2. The Director of Law be and is hereby authorized and directed to apply to a court of competent jurisdiction to have a jury impaneled to make inquiry into and assess the compensation to be paid for the interest appropriated in said properties.

SECTION 3. This council hereby directs the Director of Law to invoke the provisions of Article I, title 19 of the Constitution of the State of Ohio as the same relates to the appropriation of private property for the purpose of making or repairing public roads.






