

ORDINANCE NO. C-46-77

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 1 of ORDINANCE NO. C-37-75; TO REPEAL SECTION 2 of Ordinance No. C-9-77, AND TO AMEND SECTION 159.12(a) (1) A. of the 1976 CODE OF ORDINANCES TO ADJUST THE COMPENSATION AND CERTAIN FRINGE BENEFITS FOR THE POLICE RADIO DISPATCHERS AND TO APPROPRIATE \$2,850.00 AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City Administration and the Members of the Police Radio Dispatchers have negotiated for a new three year compensation pay schedule;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GROVE CITY, STATE OF OHIO, THAT

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. C-38-75, Section 1 "The rate of compensation for the employees of the Police Radio Dispatchers" which reads:

SECTION 2. Section 159.12 (a) (1) A. Entitled "Uniforms" which reads:

An account is established within the budget of the Division of Police for uniform replacement for Police Radio Dispatchers and each full time police Radio Dispatcher may draw from such account up to one hundred dollars (\$100.00) per year for uniform replacements as needed and as approved by the Chief of Police and the Director of Finance. Each Police Radio Dispatcher shall procure, keep and maintain uniforms pursuant to such regulations as established by the Director of Public Safety.

IS HEREBY AMENDED TO READ:

An account is hereby established within the budget of the Division of Police for uniform replacement for Police Radio Dispatchers and each full time Police Radio Dispatcher may draw from such account up to two hundred dollars per year for uniform replacement as needed and as approved by the Chief of Police and the Director of Finance. An additional one hundred dollars will be paid directly to each full-time Police Radio Dispatcher for maintenance and cleaning allowance. There will also be allotted one hundred dollars for one part-time Police Radio Dispatcher as a clothing allowance. The part-time Radio Dispatcher may draw against the account with the approval of the Chief of Police and the Director of Finance. All provisions pursuant to such regulations as established by the Chief of Police and/or the Director of Public Safety.

SECTION 3. There is hereby appropriated a total of \$2,850.00 from the unappropriated monies of the General Fund and credited to the following accounts.


SECTION 4. Section 2 of Ordinance No. C-9-77 is hereby repealed.

SECTION 6. This ordinance shall take effect at the earliest opportunity allowed by law.




