

ORDINANCE C - 47 - 66

TO MAKE SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION FROM THE
GENERAL FUND FOR THE PLANNING COMMISSION,
AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, an emergency exists in the usual daily operation of the Planning Commission in that it is immediately necessary to employ a Planning Consultant and to make other expenditures pertaining to planning for safe and orderly growth of the City and that said planning is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public property, health and safety.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Grove City, State of Ohio,

SECTION 1. That the Planning Commission be and hereby is authorized and directed to employ a Planning Consultant for the purpose of aiding and assisting the Planning Commission in the preparation of comprehensive plans for the safe and orderly growth of the City and to make other necessary expenditures pertaining to the preparation of such plan or plans.


SECTION 2. From the monies estimated to come into the General Fund from all sources and unappropriated for any other purpose, the amount of \$5,000 is appropriated to the following accounting codes:

Planning Commission


Materials and supplies	\$1500


