

ORDINANCE NO. C-56-69

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 174.03 (b), entitled "Fees", OF CHAPTER 174, ENTITLED "Electrical Regulations", of the 1966 Grove City Code of Ordinances, to increase said fees and to declare an emergency.

WHEREAS, it is immediately necessary to increase electrical fees for the welfare of the citizens of the City of Grove City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GROVE CITY, STATE OF OHIO, THAT

SECTION 1. Section 173.04 (b), entitled "Fees", which reads:

The fee for a permit shall be one dollar (\$1.00) plus the following:

For each outlet or fixture on a lighting circuit up to and including ten outlets or fixtures, counting each switch box or combination of ganged switch boxes as one outlet, fifteen cents (\$.15) each. Each additional outlet or fixture, ten cents (\$.10). All service installations, a charge of one cent (\$.01) per ampere rating of service switch. On a power or light wiring circuit for each motor, generator, furnace, rectifier, welder or electric range there shall be charged for each outlet or installation fifty cents (\$.50). All permanently wired electric festoons and temporary or decorative lighting shall be charged as follows: Ten sockets or less, fifty cents (\$.50). Each and every socket over ten, two cents (\$.02) each. The fees for sign connections shall be as follows: Twelve hundred watts or less to twenty five hundred, one dollar (\$1.00); twenty-five hundred and one watts or more, one dollar and fifty cents (\$1.50). Bus duct five cents (\$.05) per foot plus fixtures. Electrical work not specifically covered by such schedule of fees, shall be charged fees to be fixed in amount by the Building Inspector in proportion to the fees provided for work covered by such schedule.

IS AMENDED TO READ:

The fee for an electrical permit shall be ONE DOLLAR FIFTY CENTS(\$1.50) plus the following:

SERVICE -- 1-1/2 cents per ampere rating of switch.

ALL MOTOR OUTLETS -- \$.65 each ALL MOTOR CONNECTIONS -- \$.65
HOOKED UP SOLID -- \$1.30

FESTOONS -- Ten Sockets or Less -- \$.65 \$.02-1/2 for each one over ten

SIGNS UP TO 2500 WATTS -- \$1.50 Over 2500 Watts -- \$2.00

GENERATORS, RECTIFIER, WELDER OR RANGE PLUG - Same as motors

SWITCH BOX COUNTS SAME AS AN OUTLET -- DOORBELL TRANSFORMER - Same as outlet and fixture.

FEES FOR: BATHROOM HEATERS, VENTILATING FANS, DISHWASHERS, DISPOSALS, FORCED AIR FURNACES, RANGE AND OVEN (TABLE TOP), TRANSMISSION TRANSFORMERS-----\$1.30 each.

PLUS MOLD AND ELECTROSTRIP -- 1 outlet for each 5 ft. of mold or electrostrip.

BUS DUCT -- \$.06-1/2 per foot - \$13.00 maximum fee, plus motors.

TROLLEY DUCT -- \$.01-1/2 per foot - plus fixtures.

RADIANT PANEL HEATERS - each radiant panel up to ten, \$.70 per panel with minimum fee of \$4.00. For over ten panels the fee shall be \$.40 per panel. Maximum fee for any one dwelling unit shall be \$13.50

HEATING ELEMENT IS NOT AN OUTLET AND FIXTURE.

FLOOD LIGHTS - Where multiple sockets are all connected to one casting or outlet-one outlet and fixture for each fixture.

SECTIONAL FIXTURE - But supplied by one outlet only -- flourescent and valance lights - one outlet and one fixture for each section.

SWIVELIERS -- outlet and fixture for each sockets.

Dryers, ranges, air conditioner and compressors, fees will be \$.65 unless connected solid, then it is \$1.30

TEMPORARY SERVICES - \$.01-1/2 per ampere (limitations 30-60-90 day periods) should time run beyond limitations a new permit will be required.

WORKING PERMITS -- No work or service permits issued for new construction regardless of the type structure involved. May be considered for extensive fire damage or remodel of older buildings of large area.

LAUNDROMAT -- All Dryers & Drycleaning Machines -- \$1.30...Washers--\$.65 each

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take effect January 2, 1970.

SECTION 3. That for reasons stated in the preamble hereto and made a part hereof, this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval of the mayor.
