

ORDINANCE NO. C-57-72

AN ORDINANCE TO VACATE A PORTION OF BRYSTON ROAD

WHEREAS, on the seventh day of August, 1972, a petition by the Grove City Heights Corporation, and by its attorney, Robert E. Gunderman, owning property adjoining and abutting Bryston Road, was duly presented to Council praying that a portion of Bryston Road be vacated; and notice of the pendency and prayer said petition has been given as required by law in the Ohio Revised Code, Sec. 723.07 by publication in the Grove City Record, a newspaper of general circulation in the corporation, for six consecutive weeks, ending October 26, 1972; and

WHEREAS, Council upon hearing, is satisfied that there is good cause for such vacation as prayed for, that it will not be detrimental to the general interest and ought to be made.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GROVE CITY, STATE OF OHIO, THAT

SECTION 1. The portion of said street being situate in the State of Ohio, County of Franklin and in the City of Grove City and being all of Bryston Road between the southerly right of way line of Clark Drive and the southerly line of Grove City Heights Subdivision No. 2 as the said subdivision is shown of record in Plat Book 40, Pages 54 and 65, Recorder's Office, Franklin County, Ohio is hereby vacated.

SECTION 2. All easements for the construction, maintenance, and operation of various public utilities publicly owned and otherwise are hereby expressly reserved.


SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect at the earliest opportunity allowed by law.


