

ORDINANCE C-59-66

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 134.15, entitled "Discharge of Bows and Arrows, and other Missiles Prohibited", of CHAPTER 134 OF THE GROVE CITY CODE OF ORDINANCES, TO INCLUDE A PROVISION PROHIBITING THE THROWING AND DISCHARGING OF ANY STONE OR OTHER MISSILE FROM A PUBLIC STREET OR ALLEY INTO PRIVATE PROPERTY, AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the existing Section 134.15, entitled "Discharge of bows and arrows and other missiles prohibited", through inadvertence has neglected to prohibit the discharge or throwing of stones or other missiles from any public street, way or alley into any private lot, ground or building; and

WHEREAS, such an act should be specifically prohibited so as to carry out the spirit and intent of said section; and

WHEREAS, the prohibiting of such act or acts directly affects the safety, health and welfare of the citizens of the City of Grove City and ought be immediately provided for.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Grove City, State of Ohio, that

SECTION 1. Section 134.15, entitled "Discharge of bows and arrows and other missiles prohibited", which reads:

Whoever shall throw or cast any stone or other missile or discharge any arrow, cross-bow, bolt, or other contrivance or eject, discharge or otherwise throw or shoot any missile, pellet, "BB", stone, bolt, metal or other substance capable of causing injury to anyone in or upon any street, alley, park or other public ground or from or out of any yard, lot or building into any yard, lot, street, alley, park or other public or private ground, or whoever shall throw, discharge or shoot any stone or other missile at, into or against any public or private building in the city shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined not less than five dollars nor more than fifty dollars. Provided, that nothing in this section shall be construed to prohibit or render it unlawful to possess, use or furnish for use, bows and arrows in, on, and upon any public ground or park belonging to the City of Grove City for the purpose of participating, receiving and being given instruction and training in archery tournaments, target practice, marksmanship and the proper handling, use and care of which at the time of such instruction or use is under the supervision and control of a competent adult instructor; provided that the giving of such instruction and training and use is sponsored and supervised by an organization or association which is and continues to be approved for this purpose by the City of Grove City, or said instructor is the parent of the person receiving such instruction.

discharge or shoot any stone or other missile from any public street, way or alley into any private lot, ground or building in the city shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined not less than five dollars nor more than fifty dollars.

Provided, that nothing in this section shall be construed to prohibit or render it unlawful to possess, use or furnish for use, bows and arrows in, on and upon any public ground or park belonging to the City of Grove City for the purpose of participating, receiving and being given instruction and training in archery tournaments, target practice, markmanship and the proper handling, use and care of which at the time of such instruction or use is under the supervision and control of a competent adult instructor; provided that the giving of such instruction and training and use is sponsored and supervised by an organization or association which is and continues to be approved for this purpose by the City of Grove City, or said instructor is the parent of the person receiving such instruction.

SECTION 3. That for reasons stated in the preamble hereto and made a part hereof, this Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval of the Mayor.
