

ORDINANCE NO. C-60-77

(as amended)

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 1 OF ORDINANCE NO. C-38-75 TO ADJUST THE COMPENSATION FOR THE POSITIONS OF CLERK-TYPIST, ACCOUNT CLERKS I and II AND THE SECRETARY-RECEPTIONIST; TO AMEND SECTIONS 159.10(b)(1)(A) and 159.11(b)(1) OF THE GROVE CITY CODE OF ORDINANCES TO ADJUST FRINGE BENEFITS

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BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GROVE CITY, STATE OF OHIO,  
THAT

SECTION 1. The rate of compensation for Clerk-Typist, Account Clerk I, Account Clerk II and Secretary-Receptionist as set forth in Ordinance No. C-38-75 and reads:

SECTION 2. Section 159.11(b)(1)(A) of the Code of Ordinances entitled "Holidays" which reads:

- (A) Employees of the Service Departments, in addition to the holidays mentioned above, shall receive their regular compensation for time off one-half day on General Election Day and one-half day on Primary Election Day.

IS HEREBY AMENDED TO READ:

- (A) Employees of the Service Departments, Clerk-Typists, Account Clerk II, Account Clerk I and Secretary-Receptionist, in addition to the holidays mentioned above, shall receive their regular compensation for time off one-half day on General Election Day and one-half day on Primary Election Day.

SECTION 3. Section 159.11 (b)(1) of the Code of Ordinances entitled "Vacations" which reads:

(1) All full-time employees, including full-time hourly rate employees, after one year of service with the City shall be entitled to the following weeks of vacation with pay annually:

- A. One year through seven years: 80 hours or two weeks.
- B. Eight years through thirteen years: 120 hours or three weeks.
- C. Fourteen years through nineteen years: 160 hours or four weeks.
- D. Twenty or more years: 200 hours or five weeks.

With the exception of the Service Departments which shall be entitled to the following weeks of vacation with pay annually:

- A. One year through six years: 80 hours or two weeks.
- B. Seven years through twelve years: 120 hours or three weeks.
- C. Thirteen years through nineteen years: 160 hours or four weeks.
- D. Twenty or more years: 240 hours or six weeks.

IS HEREBY AMENDED TO READ:

(1) All full-time employees, including full-time hourly rate employees, after one year of service with the City shall be entitled to the following weeks of vacation with pay annually:

- A. One year through seven years: 80 hours or two weeks.
- B. Eight years through thirteen years: 120 hours or three weeks.
- C. Fourteen years through nineteen years: 160 hours or four weeks.
- D. Twenty or more years: 200 hours or five weeks.

With the exception of the Service Departments, Clerk-Typists, Account Clerk II, Account Clerk I and Secretary-Receptionist which shall be entitled to the following weeks of vacation with pay annually:

- A. One year through six years: 80 hours or two weeks.
- B. Seven years through Twelve years: 120 hours or three weeks.
- C. Thirteen years through nineteen years: 160 hours or four weeks.
- D. Twenty or more years: 240 hours or six weeks.

SECTION 4. There is hereby appropriated at total of \$2,390.00 from the unappropriated monies of the General Fund and credited to the following accounts:


SECTION 5. The provisions of this ordinance shall be retroactive to May 1, 1977.

SECTION 6. This ordinance shall take effect at the earliest opportunity allowed by law.




