

ORDINANCE NO. C-81-72

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE ADMINISTRATIVE ASSISTANT/DIRECTOR OF FINANCE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A TEMPORARY SEWAGE TREATMENT PLANT, PHASE I AND TO APPROPRIATE \$165,000. AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, an emergency exists in the treatment of sewage within the city limits of Grove City which affects the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Grove City, and

WHEREAS, additional sewage treatment facilities are required to meet the City of Grove City's responsibilities as stipulated in Ordinance No. C-36-72, and

WHEREAS, a time lag exists between the receipt of revenue and the need for treatment,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GROVE CITY, STATE OF OHIO, THAT


SECTION 1. The Administrative Assistant/Director of Finance be authorized to enter into a contract, according to law, for the work necessary to construct a "Temporary Sewage Treatment Plant" on Republican Run at Stringtown Road and I-71, Phase I and that \$165,000.00 be appropriated from the Sewer Capital Improvements Fund for the construction and inspection of said project.


SECTION 2. All funds not expended for the construction of said plant shall be returned to the Sewer Capital Improvements Fund.


SECTION 3. All funds received for the gallonage fee for the new treatment requirements in the area tributary to the project be credited to the Sewer Capital Improvements Fund.

SECTION 4. That for reasons stated within the preamble hereto and made a part hereof this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.


