

ORDINANCE NO. C-81-79

AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE REIMBURSEMENT OF A PORTION
OF THE GALLONAGE FEE AND TO APPROPRIATE \$2,655

WHEREAS, the Republican Run Treatment Plant was constructed in part using gallonage fees from Melbourne (Brookside) Estates as provided for by Ordinance No. C-28-73; and

WHEREAS, there is a credit of \$8,402.00 due from the sewer service charges, \$3,660.00 which was made as authorized by Ordinance No. C-67-78;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GROVE CITY, STATE OF OHIO, THAT

SECTION 1. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to refund the owners or their successors of Melbourne Estates the sewer service charge collected since May 2, 1978 as provided for in Section 939.12 of the Grove City Code of Ordinances and its preceding section in the amount of \$2,655.

SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated from the unappropriated monies of the Sewer Fund the amount of \$2,655 to pay this reimbursement.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect at the earliest opportunity allowed by law.






