

ORDINANCE NO. C-90-72

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR ADDITIONAL LEGAL COUNSEL FOR THE CITY OF GROVE CITY, OHIO, AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF LAW TO EMPLOY ASSISTANTS IN CONNECTION WITH THE PROSECUTION OF CRIMINAL AND TRAFFIC CASES IN THE MUNICIPAL COURT OF FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO, SETTING THE COMPENSATION OF SAID ASSISTANTS, AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, there is a need for the services of assistant solicitors in connection with the prosecution of criminal and traffic cases in the Franklin County Municipal Court, Columbus, Ohio, and

WHEREAS, there is an immediate need for these services for the public safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Grove City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GROVE CITY, STATE OF OHIO,


SECTION 1. That the Director of Law be, and he hereby is, authorized to employ as his assistant members of the legal staff of the Prosecutor's Office of the City of Columbus, Ohio, for the purpose of representing the City of Grove City in criminal and traffic cases pending or which in the future might be pending in the Franklin County Municipal Court, Columbus, Ohio.

SECTION 2. That said assistants provided for in Section 1, above, shall have and exercise the same powers as the Director of Law in connection with the prosecution of criminal and traffic cases in the Franklin County Municipal Court, Columbus, Ohio.

SECTION 3. That said assistant solicitors shall be paid the sum of Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) per hour for their services on behalf of the City of Grove City; that the Columbus City Prosecutor's Office shall bill the City of Grove City on a case-by-case basis, and the City of Grove City shall pay the compensation provided for above to the Columbus City Prosecutor's Office.

SECTION 4. That for reasons stated in the preamble and made a part hereof, this ordinance is declared an emergency measure and shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval of the mayor.


