

RESOLUTION NO. CR-14-90

A RESOLUTION TO SET FORTH, AS REQUIRED BY SECTION 709.031 OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE, THE MUNICIPAL SERVICES THAT CAN BE FURNISHED TO A 6.660+ ACRE TRACT NORTH OF GANTZ ROAD IN JACKSON TOWNSHIP UPON ITS ANNEXATION TO THE CITY OF GROVE CITY

WHEREAS, a petition to annex 6.660+ acres on the north side of Gantz Road and west of Gantz Road North to the City of Grove City was signed by Charles M. Suttles, Jr. , Secretary/Treasurer for Canann Land Church and filed with the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio and

WHEREAS, a hearing on this petition is scheduled before the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County on April 4, 1990; and

WHEREAS, Section 709.031 of the Ohio Revised Code require that the municipal legislative authority of the municipality to which the annexation is proposed adopt a statement indicating what services, if any, the municipal corporation will provide to the territory proposed for annexation upon its annexation;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GROVE CITY, STATE OF OHIO, THAT

SECTION 1. Upon its annexation to the City of Grove City, the 6.660+ acre tract north of Gantz Road West and west of Gantz Road North proposed for annexation by Canaan Land Church will receive the following municipal services from the City of Grove City:

Fire & Emergency Medical:	Jackson Township will continue to provide fire protection and emergency medical services. Response Time: 2 minutes
Police:	Subject property is within the overall area now covered by the Grove City Police cruisers. Response Time: under 5 minutes
Water:	There is an existing water line in Gantz Road in front of the tract proposed for annexation
Sanitary Sewer:	No sanitary sewer service is available to this property at this time
Garbage & Refuse Collection:	Subject property is now serviced by and would continued to be serviced by the same private collection service that now serves the incorporated area of the city.

SECTION 2. This resolution shall take effect at the earliest opportunity allowed by law.


