A RESOLUTION PROCLAIMING THE WEEK OF
APRIL 20 - 26, 1992 AS "GROVE CITY CLEAN COMMUNITY WEEK"

WHEREAS, the City of Grove City, Ohio has over the past several years been very active in providing Recycling and Beautification Projects for the entire community; and




SECTION 1. This Council and Mayor Richard L. Stage proclaim April 20 - 26, 1992 as "Grove City Clean Community Week".

SECTION 3. This resolution shall take effect at the earliest opportunity allowed by law.




