

RESOLUTION NO. CR-31-99

A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO SEEK FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FROM THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR FUNDING THE BIKE PATH AROUND THE "BIG SPLASH AT EVANS PARK" PROJECT

WHEREAS, the Intermodal Surface Transportation Efficiency Act of 1991 (ISTEA) established funding for a Transportation Enhancement Program (TEP) which was renewed in the Transportation Equity Act for the 21<sup>st</sup> Century (TEA-21); and

WHEREAS, transportation enhancement is defined as historical site enhancement, scenic and environmental enhancement, and pedestrian and bicycle facilities, associated with an existing or proposed transportation project; and

WHEREAS, the Ohio Department of Transportation has elected to sub-allocate part of its Transportation Enhancement Program (TEP) funding to the Mid-Ohio Regional Planning Commission; and

WHEREAS, the City of Grove City has determined that it is necessary to submit an application for financial assistance for the Bike Path Around the "Big Splash @ Evans Park" project.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GROVE CITY, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. The City Administrator is hereby authorized to apply to the Mid-Ohio Regional Planning Commission and the Ohio Department of Transportation for financial assistance for the following project:


Bike Path Around the "Big Splash @Evans Park"




SECTION 3. This resolution shall take effect at the earliest opportunity allowed by law.
