

RESOLUTION NO. CR-46-95

A RESOLUTION TO SET FORTH, AS REQUIRED BY SECTION 709.031 OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE, THE MUNICIPAL SERVICES THAT CAN BE FURNISHED TO A 1.247± ACRE TRACT ON THE NORTH SIDE OF STRINGTOWN ROAD, EAST OF JACKPOT RD. IN JACKSON TOWNSHIP, UPON ITS ANNEXATION TO THE CITY OF GROVE CITY

WHEREAS, a petition to annex 1.247± acres on the north side of Stringtown Road, east of Jackpot Road, in Jackson Township to the City of Grove City and signed by Anilkumar Patel et al, was filed with the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio; and

WHEREAS, a hearing on this petition is scheduled before the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County on Wednesday, July 5, 1995; and


WHEREAS, Section 709.031 of the Ohio Revised Code requires that the legislative authority of the municipality to which the annexation is proposed adopt a statement indicating what services, if any, the municipal corporation will provide to the territory proposed for annexation upon its annexation.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GROVE CITY, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. Upon its annexation to the City of Grove City, the 1.247± acres on the north side of Stringtown Road, east of Jackpot Road, proposed for annexation by Anilkumar Patel, et al, will receive the following municipal services from the City of Grove City:

- Fire: Jackson Township will continue to provide Fire protection. The response time is under five minutes.
- Police: Subject property is within the overall area now covered by the Grove City police cruisers. The response time is under five minutes.
- Water: There are existing water lines in Stringtown and Jackpot Roads can service this property. Water for subject tract will be available when this water line is extended at the property owner's expense.
- Sanitary Sewer: There is an existing sanitary sewer line in Stringtown Road that can directly serve the property. Sewer for subject tract will be available upon extension at the owner/developer's expense.
- Garbage & Refuse Collection: Subject property is now serviced by and will continue to be serviced by the same private collection service that now serves the incorporated area of the City.

SECTION 2. This resolution shall take effect at the earliest opportunity allowed by law.
