

RESOLUTION NO. CR-08-07

A RESOLUTION APPOINTING AN ASSESSMENT EQUALIZATION BOARD FOR THE PUBLIC IMPROVEMENT TO BE PAID IN PART FROM SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS FOR THE PURPOSE OF WIDENING, RECONSTRUCTING, AND IMPROVING STATE ROUTE 665 BETWEEN NORTH MEADOWS DRIVE AND HOOVER ROAD, INCLUDING THE INTERSECTIONS THEREWITH, WITH RELATED LANDSCAPING, SIGNAGE, DRAINAGE AND SITE IMPROVEMENTS

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF GROVE CITY, OHIO, COUNTY OF FRANKLIN, three-fourths of all members elected thereto concurring that:

SECTION 1. Mr. Ronald Zinn, John Bednar, Dale Leach, and Steve Bennett - Alternate, three disinterested freeholders resident of the City of Grove City, Ohio are appointed as an Assessment Equalization Board to hear and determine all written objections filed in accordance with law to the estimated assessments filed with the Clerk of this Council pursuant to Resolution No. CR-80-06 of this Council declaring it necessary to make a public improvement to be paid in part from special assessments for the purpose of widening, reconstructing, and improving State Route 665 between North Meadows Drive and Hoover Road, including the inter-sections therewith, with related landscaping, signage, drainage and site improvements (the "Project"). The Assessment Equalization Board is directed to equalize such assessments as it deems proper to conform to the standards prescribed by said resolution and by law.

SECTION 2. The Assessment Equalization Board shall meet at City Hall, 4035 Broadway, Grove City, Ohio on Monday, February 26, 2007 at 6:30 p.m., for the aforesaid, and on completion of the hearing and any adjournments, shall report its recommendations, including any changes which should be made in the estimated assessment, to this Council.


SECTION 3. The Clerk of Council is hereby directed to notify, by certified mail, each person who has filed timely written objection to the estimated assessment of the time and place of the hearing and the Assessment Equalization Board.


SECTION 4. In the event said Assessment Equalization Board determines to increase the estimated assessments against any property the owner of which has not filed an objection, or if it determines that properties not included in the original assessment list should be assessed, the Assessment Equalization Board shall notify the owner of such property by certified mail of the time and place for a hearing on said assessments.


SECTION 5. This resolution shall take effect at the earliest opportunity allowed by law.


