A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE MAYOR TO APPOINT A COMMITTEE TO ENTER INTO NEGOTIATIONS WITH THE COLUMBUS METROPOLITAN HOUSING AUTHORITY FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A HOUSING FACILITY FOR THE ELDERLY AND THE HANDICAPPED

WHEREAS, this Council has concurred with the market study and analysis of the Mid-Ohio Regional Planning Commission, in that there exists a need for a Senior Citizen and handicapped persons housing facility in Grove City and in support of this position enacted Resolution No. CR-51-78; and

WHEREAS, the erection of such a facility would bring aid and assistance to the elderly and handicapped and would enhance the general welfare and economic position of all the citizens of this city;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GROVE CITY, STATE OF OHIO, THAT

SECTION 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to appoint a committee consisting of five members to enter into negotiations with the Columbus Metropolitan Housing Authority relative to their offer to fund and construct a 50 unit housing facility in Grove City for the elderly and the handicapped.

SECTION 2. Said committee shall be appointed within ten days after the effective date of this resolution and shall be composed of one member of the City Administration, two members of the City Council, one member of the Southwestern Ministerial Association, and one Senior Citizen member.

SECTION 3. This Committee shall exist and function until the completion of the construction of these housing units and a certificate of occupancy has been issued by the Building Inspector.

SECTION 4. This resolution shall take effect at the earliest opportunity allowed by law.




