

RESOLUTION CR-21-62

A RESOLUTION TO INITIATE AN AMENDMENT TO
SECTION 6.01 OF THE CITY CHARTER

WHEREAS, Council of the City of Grove City, Ohio has determined that a general revision of the City Charter is necessary to correct typographical errors and minor discrepancies and

WHEREAS, Section 9.04 of City Charter pursuant to Article XVIII Section 9 of the Ohio Constitution vests power in council to initiate Amendments to the City Charter and

WHEREAS, No regular municipal election occurs until November 1963 but a general state election will be held on November 6, 1962, and

WHEREAS, Council has determined that a special election shall be held to coincide with the General State Election on November 6, 1962, for purpose of considering the Amendments to the City Charter and that such consideration is of immediate concern and should be immediately provided for

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Council of the City of Grove City, Ohio, that

SECTION 1. There shall be a special election on November 6, 1962 in City of Grove City for the purpose of considering this Amendment to charter of the City of Grove City, Ohio.

SECTION 2. Amendment of Section 6.01 which reads as follows:

Pursuant to the provisions of the Ohio Revised Code, Sec. 5705,18, the Council shall have authority to levy not more than three mills of general property tax for all municipal purposes, as specified in the annual budget, without a further popular vote the approval of this Charter, provided, however, that whatever millage shall be allowed by the County Budget Commission within the constitutional ten mill limitation shall be deducted from the millage which may be levied outside the ten mill limitation, so that the total levy under this Charter formunicipal purposes shall not exceed three mille unless additional levies beyond those herein authorized are

ceed three mills excluding special assessments, unless additional levies beyond those herein authorized are imposed by popular vote in the manner provided by law. Council shall have the authority to levy special assessments without regard to any limitation in this section, subject, however, to the limitations described in the Revised Code State of Ohio.

SECTION 3. The City Clerk is hereby directed to certify the question to be resolved to the Franklin County Board of Elections according to law in sufficient time as to have the issue decided at the regular municipal election next ensuing.

SECTION 4. The Clerk of Council is hereby authorized and directed to perform all other duties as are required by law to effectuate the purpose of this resolution.

SECTION 5. For reasons stated in the preamble hereto, which is hereby made a part hereof, this Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect and be in force from and after its adoption and approval by the Council of the City of Grove City, Ohio.
