Mr. Wolfe objected to these parking spaces being used exclusively by Mr. Sharp. Mayor Evans asked if Mr. DeWeese, as being chairman of the Safety Committee, could work with Mr. Fulton, the other merchants on Broadway, and Mr. Sharp to find a solution equitable to all concerned.
