January 5, 1959

Agenda Item:

1. Council called to order by George Haughn, President with following members present: Hinton, Kiehl, Rothwell, Brinkman and Harrington.
2. On motion by Hinton, 2nd by Brinkman all members voting yea approved minutes of December 19th, 1958.
3. Appropriations for 1959 were read and on a motion to adopt same made by Hinton, 2nd Harrington all voting yea.
4. Voiced opinions of members of Council Okayed proceeding with Census matter.
5. Water study rates, etc. On motion by Harrington, 2nd Kiehl that President of Council direct letter to various Civic and other organizations in Grove City requesting them to appoint one of their members to sit on a Committee to make said study, all members voting yea.

10. Subject - Cruiser matter referred to Safety Committee to determine specifications and information for proper advertising of same.
11. On motion by Kiehl, 2nd Hinton that no parking be enforced on Kingston Avenue from South Broadway to First Street on North side of Kingston Ave. All members voting yea.
12. Engineer reported that copies of plans for new disposal plant show Estimated Construction costs \$370,285.00. Construction Costs only have been submitted to State Health Department. The request for renewal of permit for operation of plant from State has been completed and signatures thereto obtained and same will be filed for hearing on same.

That on motion by Harrington, 2nd Kiehl authorizing signatures of Mayor and Clerk to sign said plans and specifications, all members voting yea.
13. Brownfield maps of street paving in Barfield Heights submitted and on motion by Hinton, 2nd Brinkman all voting yea same referred to Street Committee.
