1. The Council of the City of Grove City met in regular session on the fifth day of January, 1987 at 8:00 p.m. in the council chambers with the following members present:

5. There being no further discussion of agenda items, council reconvened.

6. Mr. Cotton read Resolution No. CR-1-87 to include new section no. 2 which reads: In addition to the recommendations of the Planning Commission, this council requests the construction of sidewalks along Hoover Road according the city engineer's specifications. Mr. Cotton then moved the resolution be approved; seconded by Mr. Stage.
