January 21, 1985

Regular Meeting

1. The Council of the City of Grove City met in regular session on the twenty-first day of January, 1985 at 8:00 p.m. in the council chambers with the following members present.

4. Pat Croushore, Haughn Road, spoke to council concerning Resolution CR-5-85 (moratorium on Group Homes). She stated that she wants a group of other people and citizens involved in this--not just city council. She further stated: We need more input into it.

John Linder, National Union of Hospital & Health Care Employees, stated that the change that Mrs. Croushore is asking is that instead of council solely being the group that is going to set regulations and standards for group homes, that a decision can be better made by input from someone from the community who is familiar with what is necessary in health care for the clients and from health care providers who actually work in state and community facilities.

Mr. List stated: Any meetings to be held by the council, it would be necessary that such meeting be open to the public

(During remarks by the council and administration) Mr. Weygandt stated: Any meetings to be held concerning the group home situation, he would inform Mr. Nicholson to inform Mrs. Croushore and her group.)

5. Speaking to Ordinance C-3-85 (Special Use Permit) were William Roth, Developer of Eastgrove Shopping Center and Jim Gill, Chesrown Used Cars.

6. Council reconvened.

7. Resolution CR-5-85 (Moratorium) was given its reading and Mr. Nicholson moved it be approved; seconded by Mr. Sheets.


Mr. List moved this ordinance be approved as an emergency; seconded by Mr. Nicholson.
