COUNCIL MINUTES

January 21, 1997

Regular Meeting

The regular meeting of Council was called to order by President Milovich at 8:00 p.m. in the Council Chamber, City Hall, 4035 Broadway.

After a moment of silent prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance, roll was called and the following members were present:

1. Mr. Faris moved to dispense with the reading of the minutes of the previous meetings and approve as written; seconded by Mr. Hurley.

**The Chair recognized Mr. Eversman, Chairman for the Service Committee, for discussion and voting of items under said committee.**

1. Ordinance C-3-97 (Authorize the Administrative Assistant to enter into an Agreement with and Request the Cooperation of the Director of Transportation for the Improvement to State Route 104) was given its second reading and public hearing and Mr. Eversman moved it be approved; seconded by Mr. Bennett.

**President Milovich, recognized Mr. Faris, Chairman of the Safety Committee, for discussion and voting of legislative agenda items under said committee.**

1. Ordinance C-4-97 (Amend Chapter 1411 of the Codified Ordinances titled "Property maintenance Code" and declare an emergency) was given its first reading.

Mr. Faris explained that this and the next ordinance is an update to our Code which will allow for the most current regulations and declares an emergency so they can be used at the earliest opportunity.

President Milovich noted that Ord. C-5-97 includes a provision for "all subsequent changes or additions thereto" and asked if this same provision should be in Ord. C-4-97. Mr. Boso stated that this provision was not included for C-4-97 because the City does adopts the Property Maintenance Code with amendments and it is prudent to review each new addition before adopting it. This does not occur with the Fire Prevention Code.

There being no additional questions or comments, Mr. Faris moved that the Rules of Council be suspended and the waiting period waived; seconded by President Milovich.

1. Ordinance C-2-97 (Support the Advertising of our Community in a Special Publication in the Columbus Dispatch and Appropriate \$10,565.00 from the Community Development Fund for the Current Expense) was given its second reading and public hearing.

President Milovich read a letter from the Grove City Area Visitors and Convention Bureau which provided support and a check for \$1,000.00 toward this project. President Milovich expressed his thanks to the Visitors & Convention Bureau noting that as the community continues to grow and the avenues we are taking to promote/create family activities, it is becoming more difficult for the "Bureau" to decide upon the projects that will support the community the best. He again expressed his appreciation.




**President Milovich asked that any new business to be brought before the attention of Council be done so at this time.**
