



The Mayor is asking for comments from the people, in writing, about inequities in their bills and any injustices that they feel imposed on them by the electric company. The Mayor and Mr. Pemberton will be meeting this week to plan some strategy and have already started research on the company's authority of the fuel adjustment clause.
