Ms. Walker explained the reasons for the ordinance was to give the city Home Rule and by passing the ordinance, the city would be removed from Columbia Gas Company's "region"; said region would have the same basic rate. By doing this, the city would negotiate with the gas company individually before the PUCO.

7. Mark Childress, Chairman of the Board for Southwest Community Health Center, Inc., and Charlotte Houseburg, Councelor for S/W, spoke to council on Ordinance C-6-84. They stated that the Health Center has been in our city for twelve years; that Federal grants have been drastically reduced; that 1984 will be a crucial year for the center; that they need individual city's financial help.

8. John Douth, Chief Engineer, Division of Water, City of Columbus spoke to council about the break in a water line near Hoover & White Roads on February 3 and the subsequence pressure problem during the morning hours.
