1. The Council of the City of Grove City, Ohio met in regular session on the seventh day of January, 1983 in the council chambers with the following members present.

2. Mr. Douglas moved to excuse President Jack Weygandt and Councilman John Hampson from the meeting; seconded by Mr. DeWeese.

Fred Becker, Kingston Avenue, also spoke to the charges by Larry's Trucking. Mr. Becker stated that the charges to Senior Citizens is unfair in relation to larger families.

9. Ordinance No. C-2-83 (Added charges by Larry's Trucking) was given its second reading and public hearing and Mr. Sheets moved it be approved; seconded by Mr. Douglas.

13. Mayor Evans gave his report for the month of January and Mr. Douglas moved it be accepted; seconded by Mr. Sheets.
