1. The Council of the City of Grove City met in regular session on the 16th day of February, 1987 in the council chambers with the following members present:

4. President Nicholson read Resolution CR-7-87, a resolution of support to the Southwest Franklin County Historical Society for establishing a committee for the celebration of the bicentennial of the Northwest Ordinance and moved its approval; seconded by Mr. Stage.

President Nicholson then presented a copy of the resolution to Barbara Howison, president of the Southwest Franklin County Historical Society and a copy to Charles Pappas, local citizen, instrumental in having a committee organized.

5. Council recessed to committees.

6. Speaking to Ordinance No. C-2-87 (Franklin County Residential Services Special Use Permit) was Ed Harper, Director of the Residential Services. Mr. Harper, in answer to questions from Charles Pappas, citizen, told the council how the complex would be built, the number of twin-single homes (3), the staffing ratios during any twenty-four hour period, the support staff and the yearly operating costs. Also speaking in favor of the special use permit were Robert Albright, attorney and a part of the Ohio Company representing land owners in the vicinity, Robert Frazier a member of the group home committee, Barry Babbart, Ellen Wilson, parent, Gene Merriman, landowner adjacent to the complex and Mayor Evans. There was no one to speak against the ordinance.


7. There being no other pertinent discussion of the other agenda items, Council reconvened.
