
20. Ordinance No. C-15-78 (Authorize design for relocation of Marlane Drive) was given its first reading. Second reading and public hearing will be on March 6.


21. Ordinance No. C-16-78 (Authorize design for waterline South of Stringtown) was given its first reading. Second reading and public hearing will be on March 6.
