

ORDINANCE NO. 3-59

To levy special assessments for constructing water mains in the Haughn Road area in the Village of Grove City, Ohio, and declaring an emergency.

Be It Ordained by the Council of the Village of Grove City, Franklin County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the assessment of the cost and expense of constructing water mains in the Haughn Road Area:

- (a) Haughn Road from Casa Boulevard to Park Street;
- (b) Angela Drive from Haughn Road westwardly approximately 325 feet;
- (c) Kingswood Drive from Angela Drive to the existing line therein at the south intersection line of Windsor Place;
- (d) Windsor Place from Kingswood Drive westwardly to east intersection line of Kingswood Drive;
- (e) Eleanor Avenue from Angela Drive to existing water main;
- (f) Kingston Avenue from Haughn Road westwardly approximately 113 feet;
- (g) Connection in Kingston Avenue eastwardly to existing water main;
- (h) Along unnamed alley from Moore Avenue to Dudley Avenue;

as heretofore reported to this Council by the Village Clerk, notice of the filing of which assessment has been given as required by law, be and the same is hereby levied and assessed upon all of the lots and lands in the Village of Grove City, Ohio, as set forth therein, the several amounts reported as

aforsaid, which assessments, together with the description of said lots and lands are now on file in the office of the Clerk of this council, and which assessments are in proportion to the benefit resulting from the improvement, and are not in excess of any statutory or constitutional limitation.

Section 2. That the total assessment against each lot or parcel of land shall be payable in cash within thirty days from and after the date of first publication of this ordinance, or, at the option of the owner, in twenty (20) annual installments with interest at the same rate as shall be borne by the bonds to be issued in anticipation of the collection of the same. All cash payments shall be made to the Treasurer of said village. All assessments and installments thereof remaining unpaid at the expiration of said thirty days shall be certified by the Clerk of this Council to the County Auditor, as provided by law, to be by him placed on the tax duplicate and collected as other taxes are collected.

Section 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the Village of Grove City, in said construction of said water mains, particularly the financing of the cost thereof, and shall take effect immediately upon its passage.

ORDINANCE NO. 2-59

To levy special assessments for constructing sanitary sewers in the Haughn Road area in the Village of Grove City, Ohio, and declaring an emergency.

Be It Ordained by the Council of the Village of Grove City, Franklin County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the assessment of the cost and expense of constructing sanitary sewers, in the Haughn Road area of the village, consisting of Patzer's Subdivision and Kingswood Heights, including the lots and lands abutting on Kingswood Avenue, Windsor Place, Angela Drive, Eleanor Avenue, Patzer Avenue, Kingston Avenue and Haughn Road, which lots and lands to be served are more particularly described as follows:

(a) Lots 7 to 39, 46 to 66, and 94 to 96, all inclusive numbers, in Patzer's Subdivision;

(b) All lots in Kingswood Heights except Lots 39 to 41, 66 to 68, and 107 to 109, all inclusive numbers.;

(c) To serve the undeveloped land abutting the entire south-

erly line of Kingswood Heights, and

(d) A connecting line from Lot 14 of Patzer's subdivision across Haughn Road to connect with the existing line of Carbrook Addition in the village;

heretofore reported to this Council by the Village Clerk, notice of the filing of which assessment has been given as required by law, be and the same is hereby levied and assessed upon all of the lots and lands in the Village of Grove City, Ohio, as set forth therein, the several amounts reported as aforesaid, which assessments, together with the description of said lots and lands are now on file in the office of the Clerk of this council, and which assessments are in proportion to the benefit resulting from the improvement, and are not in excess of any statutory or constitutional limitation.

Section 2. That the total assessment against each lot or parcel of land shall be payable in cash within thirty days from and after the date of first publication

of this ordinance, or, at the option of the owner, in twenty (20) annual installments with interest at the same rate as shall be borne by the bonds to be issued in anticipation of the collection of the same. All cash payments shall be made to the Treasurer of said village. All assessments and installments thereof remaining unpaid at the expiration of said thirty days shall be certified by the Clerk of this Council to the County Auditor, as provided by law, to be by him placed on the tax duplicate and collected as other taxes are collected.

Section 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the Village of Grove City, in said construction of said sanitary sewers, particularly the financing of the cost thereof, and shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
