March 1, 1982

Regular Meeting

1. The Council of the City of Grove City, Ohio met in regular session on the first day of March, 1982 at 8:00 p.m. in the council chambers with the following members present:

When asked by Mr. Hampson if she had any objections, Mrs. Virginia Cotton, nearest property owner, stated that she had no objections to the rezoning.

6. Mr. Hampson announced that Ordinances C-9 and C-10-82 would be tabled for further study.
7. Jack Moore, Director of the Columbus & Franklin County Disaster Services Agency, spoke to council on Ordinance C-12-82.
8. After the discussion of the agenda, Alice Litchfield, representing a delegation from the Senior Citizens Club, asked that Council rescind Resolution CR-51-81 naming the City Senior Center the E.L. Evans Senior Center. Mrs. Litchfield stated that the Senior Citizens want the chance to vote on a name for the center and bring a petition for that name to Council.

Also, speaking to this matter were: Charity Carpenter, Clara Patzer, Paul White, Eileane Simmons and Councilmen Weygandt, Sheets and Hampson.

The Senior Citizens Club President was asked to appoint a task force of three or four members to meet with the council privately on this matter.
