1. The Council of the City of Grove City, Ohio met in regular session on the fourth day of March, 1985 at 8:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers with the following members present:

During discussion of Ordinance C-14-85 (Charitable Solicitations), Mr. DeWeese announced this ordinance will include, in Section 1, subparagraph (e) which shall read: "Solicit" and "solicitations" shall mean the request, either directly or indirectly, for money or financial assistance on the plea or representation that such money or financial assistance will be used for a charitable purpose. A "solicitation", as defined herein, shall be deemed completed when made, whether or not the person making the same receives any contribution or makes any sale.

This subparagraph (e) will be included in the first reading of the ordinance.

8. Resolution CR-6-85 (Plan for B&B Distributors) was given its reading and Mr. Nicholson moved it be approved; seconded by Mr. Sheets.

In Section 3, paragraph 1: instead of first class mail it shall read:  
Certified mail return receipt requested.

In Section 3, paragraph 2: .....within five days of the date which the notice was served instead of the written "issued".

16. Mayor Evans gave his report for the month and Mr. Sheets moved it be accepted; seconded by Mr. DeWeese.




18. Mr. Gunderman asked the members of Council to send letters of support to our state representative in favor of House Bill 176 relating to Political Immunity.
