COUNCIL MINUTES

March 05, 2012

Regular Meeting

The regular meeting of Council was called to order by President Berry at 7:00 p.m. in the Council Chamber, City Hall, 4035 Broadway.

After a moment of silent prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance, roll was called and the following members were present:

1. Ms. Klemack-McGraw moved to dispense with the reading of the minutes from the previous meeting and approve as written; seconded by Ms. Albright

2. The Chair read the agenda items and they were approved by unanimous consent.

The Chair recognized Mr. Bennett - Chairman of Finance, for discussion and voting under said Committee.

Ordinance C-09-12 (Appropriate \$88,863.88 from the Central Ohio Health Care Consortium Fund for the Current Expense of Contribution Funding) was given its first reading. Second reading and public hearing will be 3/19/12.

The Chair recognized Ms. Klemack-McGraw -Chairman of Lands & Zoning, for discussion and voting under said Committee.

1. Ordinance C-10-12 (Amend the Zoning Text for the Pinnacle Club of Grove City as adopted by Ord. C-126-03) was given its first reading. Second reading and public hearing will be held on 4/16/12.
2. Ordinance C-11-12 (Approve the Rezoning of 0.654 acres located at 3722 Grove City Road from R-2 to D-1) was given its first reading. Second reading and public hearing will be held on 4/16/12.
3. Ordinance C-12-12 (Approve a Special Use Permit for an Automotive Detailing Shop for MTK Auto Detailing located at 3188 Southwest Blvd.) was given its first reading. Second reading and public hearing will be held on 3/19/12.

The Chair asked that any new business to be brought before the attention of Council be done so at this time.

The Chair recognized members of Administration and Council for closing comments.

1. Mayor Stage reminded every one to vote tomorrow. Issue 8 is for SWCS. He announced that the next phase of the Stringtown Road improvements will be bid this week. Only part of the power lines will be buried. Ms. Klemack-McGraw questioned why all the lines weren't being buried, as requested by Council in a Resolution several years ago. The Administration said cost. Mr. Berry asked to see the quote for the burial of those lines. Director Spring said he would get that to Council. Mayor Stage

noted that SWACO notified the City today that they will not honor their agreement to have their trucks use the S.R. 62 exit rather than the S.R. 665 exit off I-71. He said they will be objecting to that. Finally, Grove City was recognized on Sunny 95 for the Hometown Hero, Mr. Kirk Bohanan, who is a great example of Grove City. It will air thru the month of March.


