1. Council met in special session with President Norris in the Chair.

2. Roll call showed the following councilmen present:

3. Mr. Norris suggested a meeting with Columbus officials in order to determine what sort of contract they might have to offer with regard to tying into Big Run sewer line.

4. Mr. Mitchell presented costs of various plans for sewage disposal in Grove City.

1958 - To increase present plant capacity \$440,000.00
(present cost \$464,000.00
11,000 capacity)

City of Columbus Trunk sewer \$485,000.00 to Columbus Sewage Plant

City of Columbus Big Run \$375,000.00 to tap into Big Run Line

Pay Columbus estimate \$50,000.00 sewer rental plus own maintenance. this estimate of \$5,500.00 per year \$41,000.00 per year interest on revenue bonds on \$375,000.00

Plant built by mortgage revenue bonds total cost

\$510,600.00
Bond cost \$56,700.00 per year

Operating costs of own plant \$30,000.00 per year.

5. City Engineer read excerpts from a recent draft of a sewer contract between Columbus and an adjacent community pointing out various clauses in said contract which would affect Grove City.

6. Mayor Patzer read a letter from Water Pollution Board granting an extension of time for plant improvement and extension until May 15, 1960.

7. Mr. Norris requested Engineer and Finance Director draw up figures to submit to Council March 21, 1960 in order to have

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
a more definite outline of costs for increasing the capacity of the present sewage disposal plant.

8. Mr. Norris appointed Messrs. Brinkman, Rothwell, Patzer and Thomas and himself to have a discussion with Service Director Stark of Columbus regarding a contract for sewage disposal through Columbus facilities.

9. Motion by Mr. Rothwell, seconded by Mr. Brinkman that Council adjourn. A roll call vote was taken:
