 8. Bruce Kunz, representing National Revenue Corporation, spoke to Ordinance C-19-84. Mr. Pappas proposed that council look at this as taxpayers; to find other ways to collect the money due the court; to postpone for one year the hiring of a collection agency; to use the Credit Bureau and garnishment proceedings.
 9. Don Rings spoke to council and requested monies to aid the Fight the Dump campaign. He stated that the organization needs \$30,000 and is asking the city for \$10,000.
